**Highlights of admission process for the academic year 2023-24 under "Lata Mangeshkar Dance & Music Scholarship Scheme for Indian Culture" (A1209) (formerly ICCR Scholarship Scheme for Indian Culture) for pursuing study of Indian Culture such as dance, music, theatre, performing art, sculpture, Indian languages, Indian cuisine etc.**

1. ICCR is pleased to announce 100 Scholarship slots under "Lata Mangeshkar Dance & Music Scholarship Scheme for Indian Culture" (A1209) (formerly ICCR Scholarship Scheme for Indian Culture) for pursuing study of Indian Culture such as dance, music, theatre, performing art, sculpture, Indian languages, Indian cuisine etc. at Indian Universities/Institutes for the academic year 2023-24.
2. The list of University / institutes with accreditation of NAAC (A and above) rating / NIRF are listed on **A2A Scholarship Portal** (<http://a2ascholarships.iccr.gov.in>) for admission of foreign students through ICCR.
3. Admissions for the academic year 2023-24 are open. Timeline for the admission process is as below:

20-February-2023	Opening of ICCR <b>A2A Portal</b> for admissions.
30-April-2023	Last date of application to be submitted by students.
31-May-2023	Last date of Universities to inform the decision (if confirmed, intimation to Missions; if rejected, intimation to students).
30-June-2023	Last date for allocating scholarship and generating Offer Letters by Indian Mission abroad.
15-July-2023	Last date of acceptance by students.
22-July-2023	Based on the number of acceptances in the first round (if acceptances are less than the scholarship seats allocated) Indian Mission to offer scholarship to other students who were not considered in the first round
30-July-2023	Second-round students to convey their acceptances.

4. According to **A2A process**, applications will be submitted by students directly to respective universities.
5. Applicants have the option to apply to 5 Universities / institutes in the order of their preference of study. The admission, as far as possible, shall be given as per applicant's preference. However, there may be a scenario when students do not get admission in their preferred Universities / institutes due to limited number of seats on offer. Students should therefore be prepared to receive admission from any of their five preferences.

6. For AY 2023-24, a 500-word essay in English has been introduced to ascertain English proficiency. Besides, students can also submit their TOFEL / IELTS etc. Standardized Test scores, if available. Universities / Institutes may also conduct interview of the applicants online, if so required. There will be no separate English test by Missions, as was earlier. Rejected candidates will be intimated by Universities.
7. ICCR has introduced disbursement of all scholarship payment to students through PFMS w.e.f. February, 2021. This is as per GOI guidelines on direct payment to beneficiaries.
8. Students are advised to ensure that they obtain the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) equivalence also (if required). This would be stipulated by the concerned university / Institute in their provisional confirmation letter for the applicant (uploaded on **A2A portal**). In case AIU equivalence is required the student may apply for the same at the link <https://evaluation.aiu.ac.in/student/login> and bear the fees incurred on obtaining the certificate at own expense (non-reimbursable). 9. These scholarship slots economy class air-fares to the nearest airport and 3<sup>rd</sup> AC Train fare to the place of study, if so required. Air-ticket to go to India will be provided by the Mission to the selected scholars.
10. Students are advised to visit respective University / institute website courses offered, eligibility criteria and general information about the University / institute before applying for admission. The students should ensure that they are eligible for the course and meet the eligibility criteria and should submit relevant documentation as required by the Universities, in addition to the basic certificates mentioned in the application form. Students are also advised to refer to the University's Handbook / University Grants Commission's website (<https://www.ugc.ac.in>) etc.
11. The applicant's age for availing scholarship is as under:  
For Undergraduate / Postgraduate courses – between 18 to 30 years and  
For PhD Programmes – between 18 to 45 years.
12. Applicants should not have any serious health issues. It is compulsory for all ICCR scholarship students to procure Medical Insurance policy with minimum sum assured for Indian Rupees Five Lakhs per annum when they travel to India (on their own either before travel or immediately after reaching India, whichever is convenient). Students can purchase medical insurance from any of the insurance companies of their choice. However to facilitate students, **A2A portal** has two insurance companies for referral purpose. ICCR has uploaded the revised norms on its **A2A portal**.
13. ICCR may amend some provisions of scholarships from time to time and it is incumbent on students to accept the revised norms.

14. In order to ensure security of the foreign students, ICCR advises students to stay in the campus hostel, if available. However, students are allowed to stay in private accommodation if the concerned institute does not insist on staying in their hostel.
