Taxi Services



Bengaluru, Karnataka

Bangalore, officially Bengaluru, is the capital of the Indian state of Karnataka. Bengaluru renamed few years ago, is the most happening city of India. Bengaluru popularly known as Garden City of India, Pensioner's Paradise, Pub city, Silicon Valley and IT City of India. In terms of advanced education – be it in Medicine, Engineering, Space Research, Science and technology, Bengaluru has top institutions of the country located here. Kannada being the native language, people from all states of our country resides here making it a truly cosmopolitan and multilingual city. People of different nationalities have also made Bengaluru their home and thus making it a Global City.

Among Bangalore's most engaging landmarks is Cubbon Park Dating back to 1864 and filled with plants and buildings, and statues, this historic park offers a serene respite from the bustling metropolis. Nearby, Vidhana Soudha is the seat of Karnataka's Legislative Assembly. Also noteworthy is the 16th-century Bangalore Fort. Originally made of mud, it was built by the city's founder, Kempe Gowda. For another engaging glimpse into the past, visit Tipu's Palace. Called the "Envy of Heaven," this medieval-looking wooden palace features five ornate arches and minarets. Bright paintings adorn its walls and ceilings. History enthusiasts will enjoy Gandhi Bhavan, a comprehensive gallery on Mahatma Gandhi, while nature lovers might prefer a stroll through the diverse botanical gardens laden with exotic foliage and flora at Lalbagh Gardens. Built in the 16th century to worship the sacred bull Nandi, Bull Temple is also worthy of a visit.

Retail culture abounds here, as seen in its futuristic shopping centres like the Forum Value Mall. Retaining old-world charisma, other historical and cultural sites of interest in Whitefield include St. Joseph's Convent, its oldest school; the picturesque Our Lady of Lourdes Church and the Stations of the Cross statue, both of which are set upon a hill; and the ashram Brindavan, once the summer home of the revered religious leader Sri Sathya Sai Baba.

Mysore

Shravanabelagola Temple, District Hassan

In this Day trip from Bengaluru visit Shravanabelagola which is about 140 KMs from Bengaluru. At Shravanabelagola visit Gomateshwara Statue and Kalamma Temple. Also known as the Bahubali Statue, this 10th century statue is 17 meters high and beleived to be one of the tallest Gomateshwara statues in the world. It was constructed by General of King Rajamalla, Chamundaraya during the Ganga Dynasty. This 10th century pillar is situated on Vindhyagiri hill not far from Bahubali statue. It rests on an elevated platform and has elaborate carvings from bottom to top.






